



### How Do People Want to Move Around the Campus?


- Walking is the most common preferred mode

   zones or shuttles (especially for seniors and families)

- Notable mentions of learning, healing, and entertainment





# What Did Different Groups Emphasize?

**AFS:** Prioritized family access, affordable housing, and community belonging.

**ESL:** Emphasized safety, green space, and cleanliness

**TWC:** Highlighted mobility connections, education, and wellness



Despite differences, all groups seek inclusive, safe, and culturally rooted spaces.

### Next Steps

#### Findings to be implemented into the next design:

- Safe, walkable paths with shade and seating along the way
- Green, calm environments that support both relaxation and activity
- Flexible spaces for family gatherings, small events, and cultural expression
- Accessible design features lighting, rest areas, drop-off zones, and clear signage
