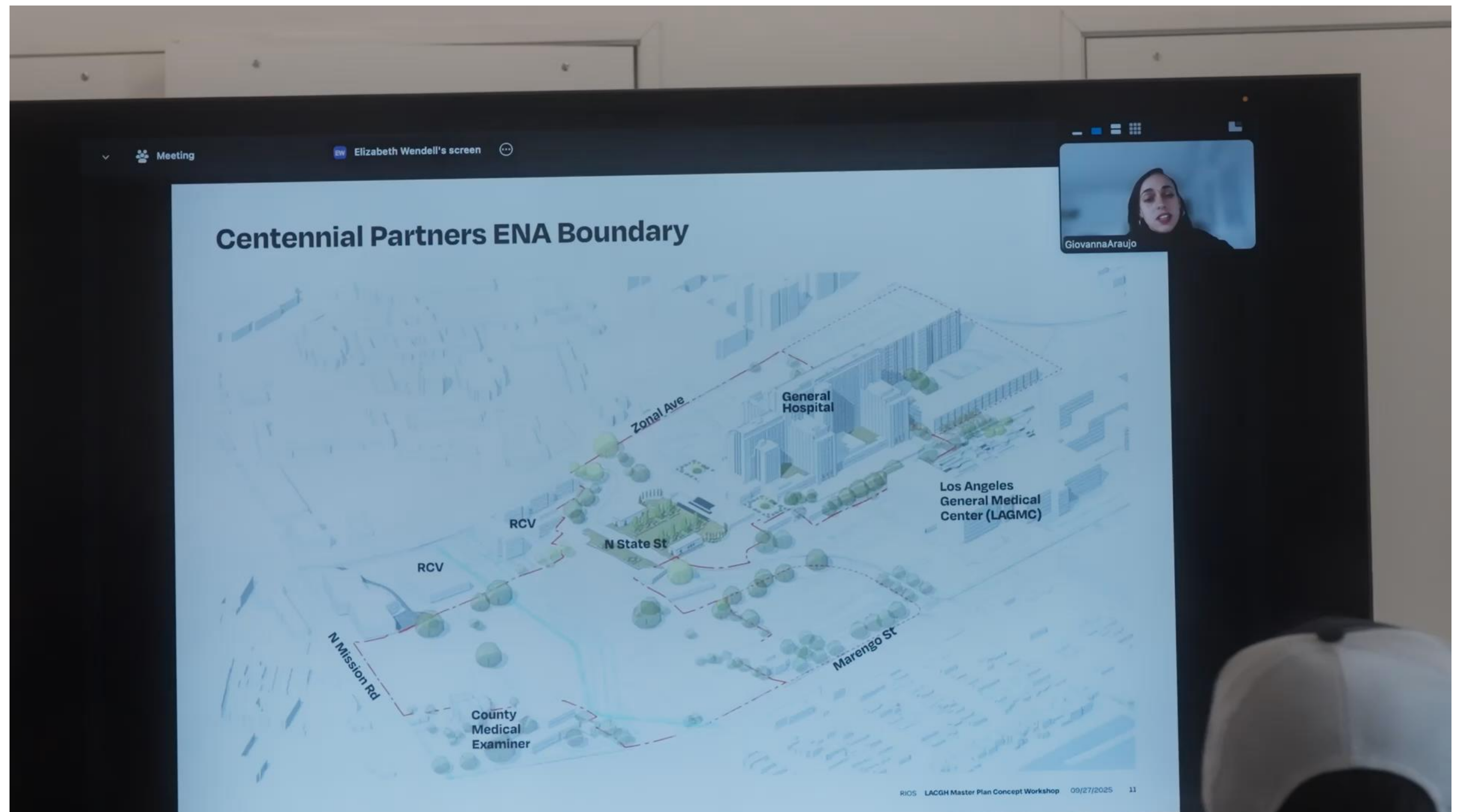

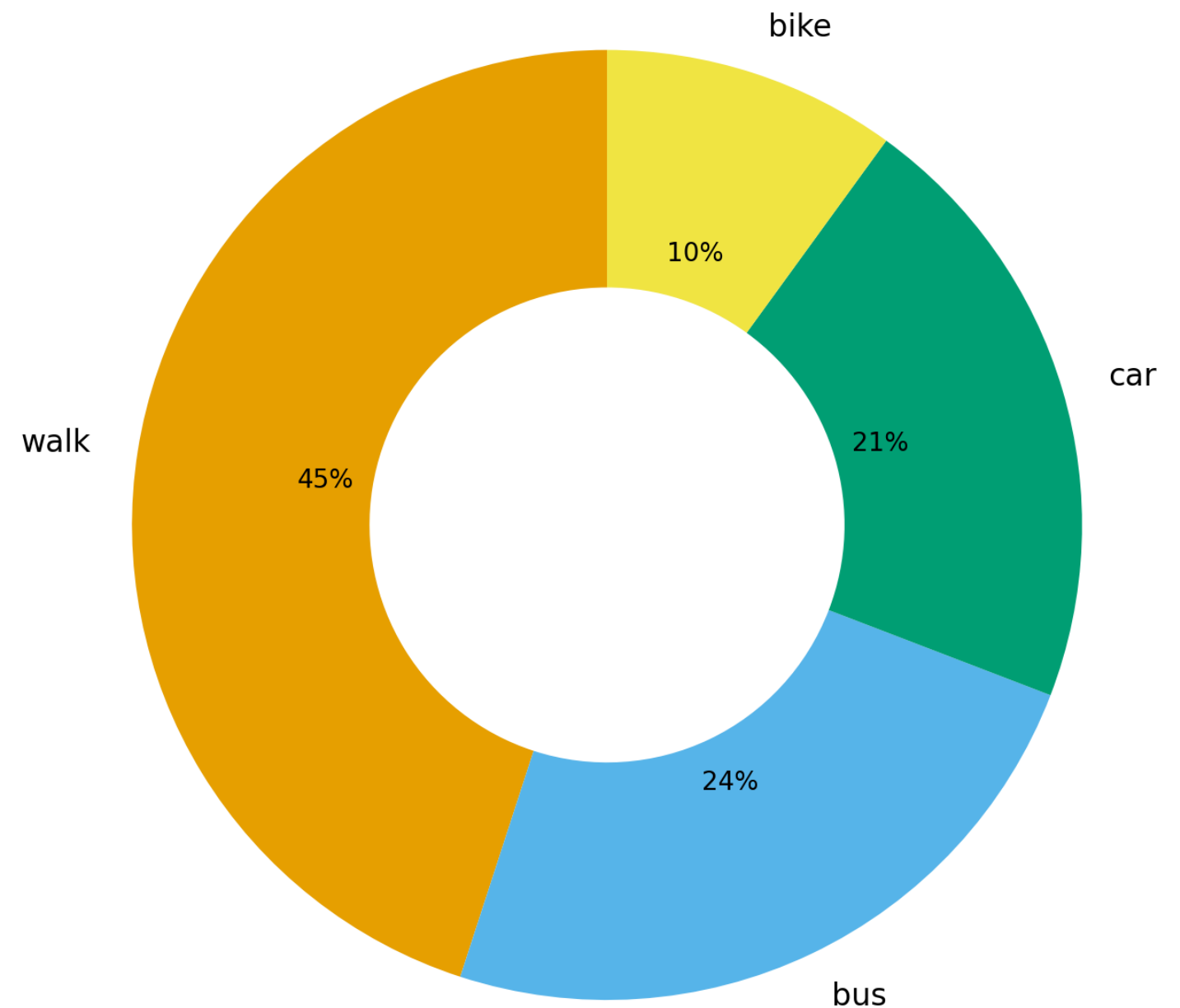

# How Do People Want to Move Around the Campus?

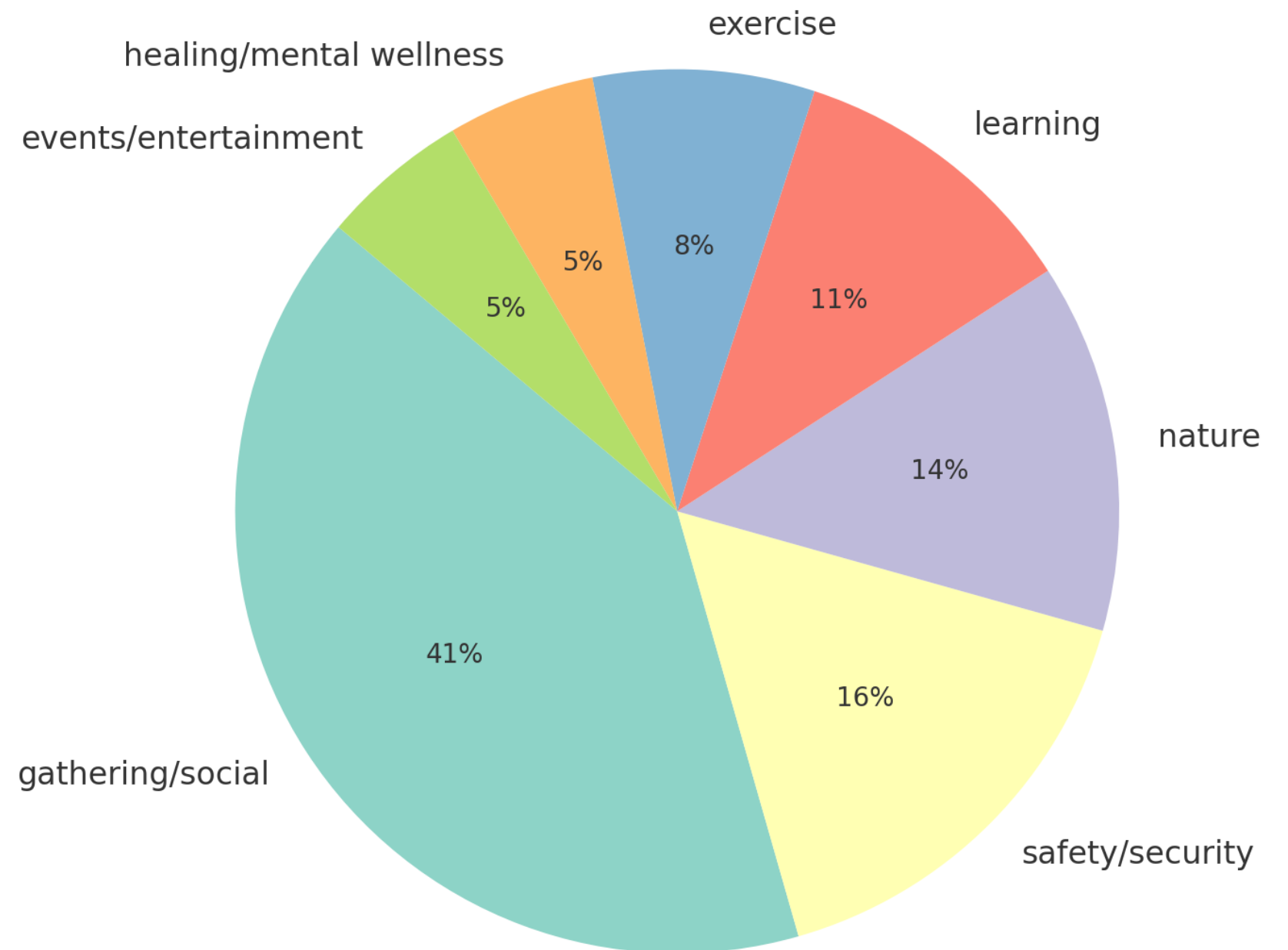
- **Walking** is the most common preferred mode
- **Bus transit** and **car access** are also frequently mentioned
- Many requested **drop-off zones or shuttles** (especially for seniors and families)



# What Do People Want to Do Here?

Responses revolved around:

- **Relax** in calm, shaded, peaceful areas
- **Gather and connect** with friends and family
- **Exercise** (walk, bike, run) and enjoy **nature**
- Notable mentions of **learning, healing, and entertainment**

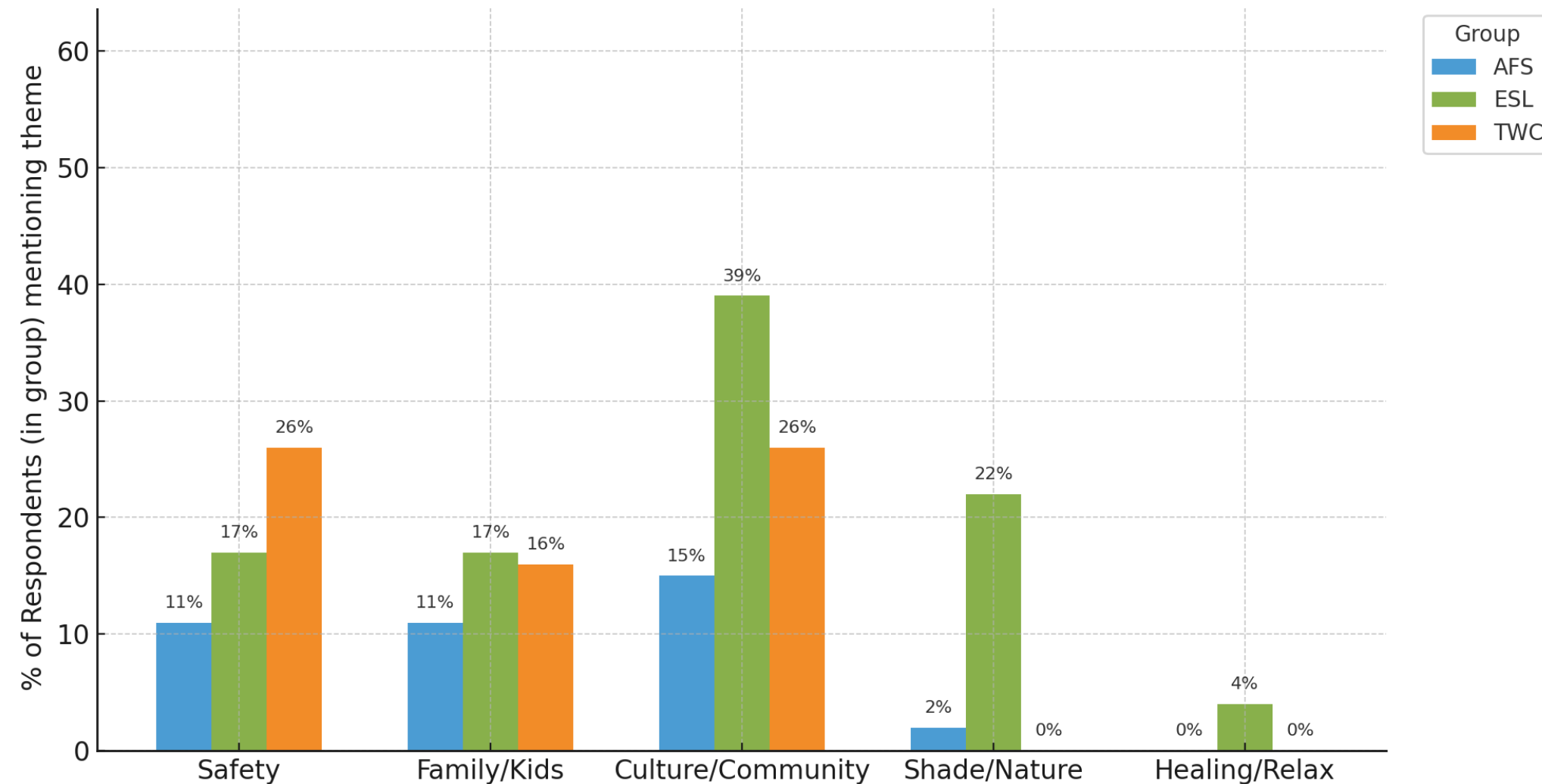


# What Did Different Groups Emphasize?

**AFS:** Prioritized family access, affordable housing, and community belonging.

**ESL:** Emphasized safety, green space, and cleanliness

**TWC:** Highlighted mobility connections, education, and wellness



Despite differences, all groups seek **inclusive, safe, and culturally rooted spaces.**

# Next Steps

## Findings to be implemented into the next design:

- Safe, walkable paths with shade and seating along the way
- Green, calm environments that support both relaxation and activity
- Flexible spaces for family gatherings, small events, and cultural expression
- Accessible design features — lighting, rest areas, drop-off zones, and clear signage
